If the goal is to breed graded stakes winners, and it is hard to imagine anyone disagreeing with that goal, then Juddmonte Farms was the wagering favorite to win its third consecutive Eclipse Award as the outstanding breeder of 2003.

Juddmonte, owned by 66-year-old Prince Khalid Abdullah, bred 37 individual winners of stakes races during 2003, an amazing number but actually one less than the previous year.

Besides 2001 and 2002, Juddmonte received the Eclipse Award for breeder in 1995. With its win in 2003, Juddmonte became the first four-time winner of the breeder award since its inception in 1974.

Of the 37 stakes winners bred by Juddmonte, 25 of those runners won a grade or group race and 10 won at the highest class in racing, winning a grade or group I race.

Of those 10 grade/group I winners,

three were Eclipse Award finalists: 3-year-old male Empire Maker, older female Sightseek, and turf female Heat Haze.

Empire Maker spoiled Funny Cide's bid for a Triple Crown when he won the Belmont Stakes (gr. I). He also won the Wood Memorial (gr. I) and Florida Derby (gr. I). Sightseek won four grade I races in succession—the Humana Distaff, Ogden Phipps, Go for Wand, and Beldame. Heat Haze won the Beverly D. (gr. IT) and Matriarch (gr. IT).

Juddmonte owns farms in Kentucky, England, and Ireland, which house about 200 broodmares and numerous stallions.

# Jerry Bailey

Jerry Bailey is racing's version of Starship Enterprise Capt. James T. Kirk, boldly going where no man has gone before. In 2003, he won more stakes (70) in one year than any other rider in history, and his mounts set a single-season earnings mark of \$23,354,960. Bailey also established another riding record when he scored his 14th victory in the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships while guiding Six Perfections to the wire first in the NetJets Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT).

Bailey's 2003 statistics show he had fewer mounts (776) than any of North America's other top 10 money-earning riders and the second-fewest victories (206) than any among the top six. But he was still able to dominate because he captured 27% of the races he rode in and 30% of the added-money events.

While many horsemen seek him out to ride their best runners, Bailey enjoyed his most rewarding partnership with trainer Bobby Frankel—an alliance that has produced impressive results for several years now. In 2003,

Bailey guided Empire Maker to triumphs in the Florida Derby, Wood Memorial, and Belmont Stakes (all gr. I) for Frankel. Empire Maker spoiled Funny Cide's Triple Crown in the Belmont, with Bailey riding aggressively and pushing the pace. Empire Maker took command in the final turn while Funny Cide faded.

Bailey was also aboard other Frankel stars such as Aldebaran, Medaglia d'Oro, Sightseek, and Spoken Fur. Top horses from outside Frankel's barn ridden by Bailey included Birdstone, Congaree, Composure, Cuvee, Lady Tak, and Sulamani.

Bailey's 2003 Eclipse Award win moves him into uncharted territory, giving him an unprecedented fourth consecutive title as North America's outstanding rider. It is his seventh Eclipse overall, another milestone no other jockey has ever reached.
