Juddmonte Farms added to its growing collection of Eclipse statuettes with a second trophy for being North America's leading owner. Juddmonte, owned by 66-year-old Prince Khalid Abdullah, has won four Eclipse Awards for top breeder—in 1995, 2001, 2002, and 2003—as well as the Eclipse for top owner in 1992 and 2003. As an owner in 2003, Juddmonte had 33 winners from 122 starts and earnings of \$6,265,030 to rank third in North America.

Among the stakes winners owned by Juddmonte are three Eclipse Award finalists. One of those is Empire Maker, who spoiled Funny Cide's bid for a Triple Crown when he won the Belmont Stakes (gr. I). He also won the Wood Memorial (gr. I) and Florida Derby (gr. I). He will stand his first season at stud at Juddmonte in Kentucky in 2004.

Sightseek, a finalist in the older female division, won four grade I races (in succession)—the Humana Distaff,

Ogden Phipps, Go for Wand, and Beldame. Heat Haze, a finalist in the female turf horse division, won the Beverly D. (gr. IT) at 13/16 miles and the Matriarch (gr. IT) at a mile. The other grade/group I winners owned by Juddmonte were Etoile Montante, Brian Boru, American Post, Oasis Dream, Nebraska Tornado, Three Valleys, and Bates Creek.

Juddmonte owns farms in Kentucky, England, and Ireland, which house about 200 broodmares and numerous stallions. Abdullah claims to be semi-retired from his business, Mawared, which is involved in such businesses as insurance, catering, cleaning, cement, foodstuffs, and electronics. ☐

Bobby Frankel

By all accounts, 2002 was Bobby Frankel's year. He had 60 stakes wins from January to December, \$17,748,340 in earnings, won 24% of all his races, trained two Eclipse Award finalists, and earned an Eclipse himself. Then came 2003.

In 2003, one of the only categories where Frankel did not outperform his previous year's stats was stakes victories—he had 54. However, he had more earnings, \$19,143,289, a higher win percentage, 28%, and a higher in-the-money percentage, 61%. In addition, five horses in his care are Eclipse Award finalists: Aldebaran, Empire Maker, Heat Haze, Medaglia d'Oro, and Sightseek. For himself, Frankel scored his fourth straight Eclipse

Beyond basic dollars, another difference between 2002 and 2003 for Frankel was the grade I column. In 2002, he trained the winners of 14 grade I races. In 2003, that number jumped to 25, and included key wins

in big races like Empire Maker's Belmont Stakes (gr. I), Medaglia d'Oro's Whitney Handicap (gr. I), and Sightseek's Beldame (gr. I). All three of those runners finished among the top 15 horses in North America by earnings in 2003, as did another Frankel trainee, Peace Rules; Aldebaran and Heat Haze made it into the top 20. Still, when all of their earnings are added together, they only account for just over \$9 million, not even half of Frankel's total.

Frankel's accomplishments in 2003 broke three records—the earnings record by a trainer, total number of grade I wins, and the record for the most wins by a trainer at Hollywood Park. Was 2003 Bobby Frankel's year? We'll have to wait until 2004 to say for sure. ☐
