Plaintiff J. Paul Reddam's *Ex Parte* Application For (A) A Temporary Restraining Order And (B) An Order To Show Cause Re Issuance Of Preliminary Injunction (the "Application") came on for hearing on March 29, 2007, at 8:30 a.m. Appearances were as noted on the record. Based on the parties' agreement, the Court rules on the Application as follows:


1. The Application is GRANTED to the extent provided in this Order.
2. A hearing on the Order to Show Cause (the "OSC") requested by Plaintiff J. Paul Reddam ("Reddam") shall take place on April 17, 2007, at 8:30 a.m. in Department C12 of this Court, at which time Defendant Fifth Third Bank ("Defendant") is required to appear and show cause why a Preliminary Injunction should not be granted for the pendency of this action prohibiting Defendant, and others acting in concert with it, from (a) taking any action to recover possession of the thoroughbred horse named Great Hunter owned by Reddam based on any alleged security interest or other interest with respect to Great Hunter, (b) selling, assigning, or transferring any alleged security interest, or any other interest, in Great Hunter to any person or entity, and (c) taking any other action that would interfere with Reddam's ownership of Great Hunter and his ability to race the horse.
3. Defendant's opposition papers shall be served via e-mail, fax, or personal service on Reddam's counsel of record by no later than 4:30 p.m. on April 10, 2007, and filed with this Court by no later than April 10, 2007.
4. Reddam's reply papers, if any, shall be served via e-mail, fax, or personal service on Defendant's counsel of record by no later than 4:30 p.m. on April 13, 2007, and filed with this Court by no later than April 13, 2007.
5. This Order shall be effective immediately.
6. Accordingly, pending the hearing on the OSC, Defendant, and its assignees or transferees, if any, and others acting in concert with Defendant, are prohibited from (a) taking any non-judicially approved action to recover possession of Great Hunter based on any alleged security interest or other interest with respect to Great Hunter; (b) selling, assigning, or transferring any alleged security interest, or any other interest, in Great Hunter to any person or entity without notifying the buyer, assignee, or transferee of the existence of this Order; and (c) taking any other


1 non-judicially approved action that would interfere with Reddam's ownership of Great Hunter and his
 2 ability to race the horse. For purposes of this paragraph, any application or other request for "judicial
 3 approval" for any action by Defendant with respect to Great Hunter pending the hearing on the OSC
 4 shall be accompanied by notice to Reddam's counsel in accordance with applicable court rules and
 5 statutes. Reddam is entitled to assert any and all defenses to any such application or other request
 6 made by Defendant or its assignee or transferee. Defendant represents that it has not yet received any
 7 judicial approval to take any action with respect to Great Hunter


